Land survey, Compass Instruction & Map Drawing

Working with 2 local surveyors, youth will learn to use compasses, modern day survey equipment and learn how boundary lines are measured and established. Youth will create a base map from a recent survey map. This working document will enable the youth to make recommendations to the ELMMCC for future wildlife enhancement projects.

Natural Resource Assessment, Inventory & Recommendations

Completed projects will be picked up by NH Fish and Game and distributed throughout NH's bodies of water.
